## FOR THE WEEK OF MAY 11, ANNO DOMINI MMVIII

**NOTES FOR THE OFFICE IN PASCHALTIDE** – Throughout Paschaltide (through None of the Saturday after Pentecost), at all Offices, “Alleluia” is added to all Antiphons when they are said entire, and to all  $\Psi$   $\Psi$  and  $\Re$   $\Re$ . / But “Alleluia” is not added to the  $\Psi$   $\Psi$  in the Preces at Prime and Compline when they are said, nor to “Right dear” &c. at the end of Prime. / “Alleluia, alleluia” is added to the Short  $\Re$   $\Re$  at Vespers and Lauds, as noted in their places. / At Vespers and Lauds, the Commemoration of the Holy Cross is said in place of the Suffrage of All Saints. / At Prime, the Chapter “Now unto the King” is always said, even on Ferias. / The Antiphon of the BVM, *Regina caeli* (“O Queen of Heaven”) is said until None of the Saturday in the Octave of Pentecost. / There is no kneeling during Paschaltide during the Office.

**NOTES FOR THE MASS IN PASCHALTIDE** – The color of the season is white but cloth-of-gold may be used instead. / The Paschal Candle is lighted at High (Sung) Mass and sung Vespers on Sundays until Ascension Day: it may also be lighted on other days during this season, and for other liturgical services, such as a parochial Low Mass. But it is never lighted for or any other non-liturgical service; nor is it lighted for any observance for which the color is purple or black. / *Vidi aquam* takes the place of *Asperges* at the beginning of the principal Sunday Mass. / *Gloria in excelsis* is said in all Masses, feasts and ferias alike, but not in Rogation Masses or ordinary Votives. / The double “Alleluia” is added to the Introit; and one “Alleluia” to both the Offertory and Communion. / After Low Saturday, the “Great Alleluia” is said in place of the Gradual in all Masses of the season and on feasts, but not in Rogation Masses or on the Vigil of Pentecost. / The Easter Preface is said in all Masses until the Ascension, except in that of a feast having a proper preface.

**AT TERCE** – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Sunday (84), with Ant. “Alleluia” from Psalter / Chapter, “Dearly beloved: Christ also suffered” as at Lauds (377) /  $\Psi$ . “The Lord is risen from the tomb” (378) / Collect of Sunday as above

**AT SEXT** – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Sunday (86), with Ant. “Alleluia” from Psalter / Chapter “But he committed” (378) /  $\Psi$ . “The Lord is risen indeed” (378) / Collect of Sunday as above

**AT NONE** – Proper hymn ending in Paschaltide / Pss. of Sunday (89), with Ant. “Alleluia” from Psalter / Chapter, “For ye were as sheep” (378) /  $\Psi$ . “Then were the disciples” (378) / Collect of Sunday as above

**AT VESPERS (2nd Vespers of Sunday)** – Pss. of Sunday, with Ant. “Alleluia” (111) / Chapter, “Dearly beloved: Christ also suffered” as at Lauds (377) / Short  $\Re$ , Hymn &  $\Psi$  from Ferial Office of Paschaltide (375) / Mag. Ant. “I

am the Good Shepherd” (378) / Greg. Collect of Sunday, “O God, who by the humiliation” (377); or Tik. Collect, “Almighty God, who hast given” (378) / Commem. of Ss. Nereus, etc. Ant. “Light perpetual”, V. “O ye holy” (2\*) & Collect (526) / Commem. of the Cross (146)
